2nd Reading: Observe! Mark what stands out for you while reading. Use different colors. (Names, places, events, etc.)

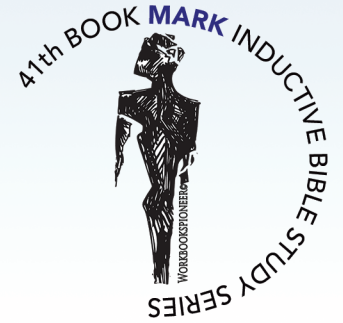
3rd Reading: Find the key verse in the book, and one in each chapter.

Chapter 6

Believers Are Dead to Sin, Alive to God

- 1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase?
- 2 May it never be! How shall we who have died to sin live in it?
- 3 Or do you not know that all of us who have been **baptized** into **Christ Jesus** have been **baptized** into His death?
- 4 Therefore we have been **buried with Him** through **baptism** into death, so that **Christ** was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.
- 5 For if we have become **united with Him** in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be **in the likeness of His** resurrection.
- 6 knowing this, that our old self was **crucified with Him**, in order that our body of sin might be **done away with**, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin;
- 7 for he who has died is **freed from sin**.
- 8 Now if we have died **with Christ**, we believe that we shall also **live with Him**;
- 9 knowing that **Christ**, having been raised from the dead, is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him.
- 10 For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.
- 11 Even so consider yourselves to be **dead to sin**, but alive to God in **Christ Jesus**.
- 12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts.
- 13 and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.
- 14 For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
